FIREFLY

Firefly is a warm-weather yarn with a subtle sheen and wonderful hand. The juxtaposition of the linen with a light-catching sheen gives it a distinctly feminine look. Firefly drapes wonderfully at a wide range of gauges – knit loosely for elegant lace or more tightly for stockinette fabrics.

SKILL LEVEL

Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

9¾" wide x 72" long (not including fringe)

YARN

Firefly by **Classic Elite Yarns**

(75% viscose, 25% linen; 50 g = approx 155 yards)

3 balls 7757 Chicory

Optional: 1 ball 7795 Thistle for fringe

NEEDLES

Knitting needles in size US 6 (4 mm) **or size to obtain gauge.**

GAUGE

16 sts and 20 rows = 4" in Mesh Stitch, blocked. **Take time to save time, check your gauge.**

Note: *Stitch gauge is more important than row gauge.*



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ABBREVIATIONS

BO: bind off
CO: cast on
k: knit
k2tog: knit 2 sts together (1 st decreased)
k3tog: knit 3 sts together (2 sts decreased)
LH: left hand
meas: measure(s)
rep(s): repeat(s)
RH: right hand
RS: right side
sl: slip
st(s): stitch(es)
tbl: through back loop
WS: wrong side
yo: yarn over (1 st increased)

PATTERN STITCHES

Mesh Stitch (multiple of 4 sts + 3)

Row 1 (WS): Knit.

Row 2 (RS): K1, *K1, yo, k3tog, yo; rep from * and end k2.

Rep rows 1-2 for Mesh stitch.

Note: Block your work periodically as you knit to assure you're maintaining the correct gauge.

SCARF

CO 39 sts.

Work in Mesh Stitch until scarf meas 72" or desired length, ending with a WS row.

BO loosely as follows:

K1, *sl st from RH needle back to LH needle and k2tog-tbl; rep from *.

Block scarf to meas.

Optional Fringe:

Cut the contrasting ball of yarn into 7 to 8" lengths.

Attach 2 strands of fringe every eyelet along one side of scarf.

Trim if desired.
